Food bank needs a winter top up to continue supporting families in financial difficulties.

Stocks at the City Mission Food Bank at 7 Park Place are running low and their annual food bank drive doesn't take place till October. They need to build up their reserves to cope with the needs of those families in the community who are experiencing financial stress. As they are the main source of emergency food in Whanganui, a lot of people are dependent on what they can provide.

What they need right now is as follows:

- Food items such as rice, sugar, milk powder, tea bags, Raro sachets, creamed corn, pasta sauce, canned soup and especially tins of tuna or salmon as they provide a cheap, nutritious form of protein as well as eggs.
- Fruit such as little apples, citrus, especially mandarins and tangerines
- Grocery items such as toilet paper, soap, toothpaste, laundry powder and crawler sized nappies.
