Reporting to Families

We will be reporting to you in two ways this term.

1. Open Evening Monday 24 August, from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm.

Come with your child any time during those hours and see the pieces of work that they, in consultation with their teacher, have chosen.



2. Seesaw Learning Journal (online or through a free app)

Some of our classes are already using Seesaw to record and comment on learning as it happens, and we are now rolling this out across the school. It means that families will be able to see samples of learning in real time, rather than waiting for a static written report at the end of the term. This term, we will be posting samples of writing, reading, and mathematics.

Each student will have their own journal, and will add photos, drawings, videos, or notes to it to show the work they are doing. When there is a new post, you can be notified by a notification on the app, by email, or by text. You will be able to celebrate and reply to comments made by your children and their teachers. You will be notified only about your child's work, and all the information about your child is kept safe and secure.

We will be sending home easy instructions for how to access Seesaw over the next week. The first post will be in a few weeks. If you would like to, you can read the Seesaw for Parents page which has links to the free app:
