Religious Education

Gospel: Matthew 16:21-27

Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone wants to come with me, he must forget self, carry his cross, and follow me. For whoever wants to save his own life will lose it; but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. Will people gain anything if they win the whole world but lose their life? Of course not! There is nothing they can give to regain their life. For the Son of Man is about to come in the glory of his Father with his angels, and then he will reward each one according to his deeds.

Gospel reflection:

Jesus is trying to teach his friends what it means to be a disciple. A disciple is someone who wants to follow in Jesus' footsteps but this isn't always easy.

Jesus also says that we should take up our cross and follow him. What can we do that shows that we follow Jesus? If we follow him we are showing that we love him too. And Jesus will always be with us helping us along the way. Jesus asks us to follow him by loving others. It can be hard to keep on loving others, especially if they aren't loving towards us. Perhaps someone said something unkind or didn't want to be friends with us. It's difficult, but Jesus wants us to keep on loving. We believe that we are a worldwide family loved by God and so we pray together:

*We pray for the Church throughout the world: that she may be a living example of God's love for all people, especially those who are in need. Lord, in your mercy...
